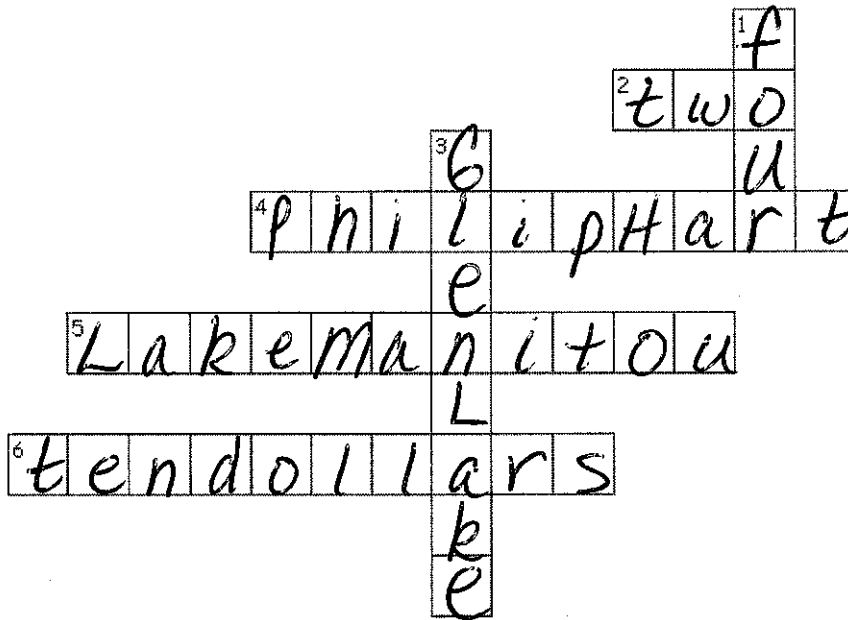

## Sleeping Bear Sand Dunes - Glen Arbor

Sleeping Bear Dunes National Lakeshore was named the "Most Beautiful Place in America" on ABC's Good Morning America. The hills, dunes, valleys, shoreline, small lakes, and streams which you'll see throughout the area were formed by the powerful forces of ice, wind, and water. During the Ice Age, glaciers spread southward burying the area under ice. Those massive glaciers enlarged river valleys and carved out the Great Lakes. They also created "Perched Dunes", the Sleeping Bear Dunes are a beautiful example of this type of dune.
