If you remember, Rick Stathakis is the Supervisor of Shelby Township, Michael Taylor is the Mayor of Sterling Heights and Thom Dionne is the Mayor of Utica. These gentlemen don't work alone. They work together with a board of trustees or city council, all elected by the people in the community, to work together to make and enforce laws and protect our rights.

When people elect representatives to make laws for them and be their leaders it is called **representative government**. We elect these representatives by voting. Try this.....
