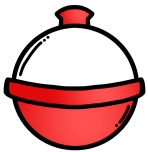
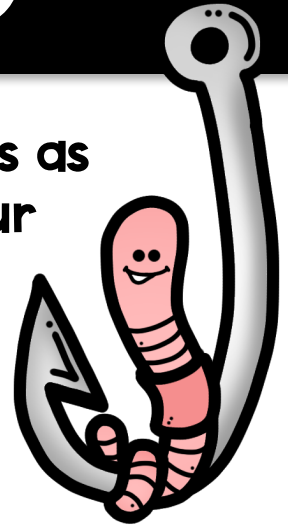


# WRITING HOOKS

**Onomatopoeia:** Splash! I dove into the pool feet first.



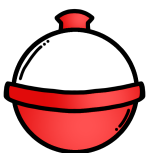
**Dialogue:** "I want to go swimming!" he yelled.
